

## **About Us**

The ACE program is a grant-funded program for WVU OB/GYN patients who need support coping with substance use. We work with women throughout pregnancy and up to 2 years postpartum. Women can enter the program at anytime throughout that time period.

ACE goes above and beyond regular prenatal and postnatal care by offering individualized services tailored to meet the needs of our participants. Whether that be finding a provider or getting connected to community resources.

ACE is funded by the West Virginia Perinatal Partnership through their Drug Free Moms and Babies Initiative.

## Services Offered

- In person and telephone support from a certified peer recovery coach
- Patient liaison services
- Referrals to obstetric and gynecologic providers
- Referrals to behavioral health providers and facilities
- Advocacy during medical appointments
- Advocacy while admitted to labor and delivery
- Connections to community recovery resources, such as 12-step meetings
- Connection to community resources, such as transportation, home visitation programs, workforce development, domestic violence resources, and legal assistance.
- Monthly group meetings with other participants for recovery support
- Gifts for reaching project milestones, such as baby items and weekly planners
