Presenters (one presenter per program) may show a maximum of 5 PowerPoint slides and will have 5-8 minutes to speak. Submissions will be reviewed by the OSR Medical Education Committee and five presentations will be selected to present during the session.

Presenters do not have to be OSR reps, but must pay the student registration fee. Registration fees for presenters will not be waived.
