Trauma skills
July through December:
Team approach: PGY 4,2,1,1

Perfused cadaver simulation training: Instructors – Grabo, Borgstrom

- 1. Penetrating neck injury
 - a. Airway: ETT, cricothyroidotomy
 - b. SCM incision: vascular exposure control of carotid injury
 - c. Exposure and repair of trachea-esophageal injury
- 2. Penetrating lower extremity injury
 - a. SFA exposure, shunt placement
 - b. 4 compartment fasciotomy
- 3. Penetrating chest injury
 - a. Left anterolateral thoracotomy, control of cardiac wound
 - b. Clamshell thoracotomy
 - c. Pulmonary tractotomy, lung resection, pneumonectomy
- 4. Blunt abdominal trauma
 - a. Exploratory laparotomy for trauma
 - b. Management of solid organ injury (liver, spleen, kidney)
 - c. Management of abdominal vascular injury (IVC, iliac)

 - a. Liver resection
 - b. Porta Hepatis Exploration
- 4. Hernia Borgstrom
 - a. Femoral Hernia
 - b. Open CBD Exploration
