AAMC Choose Your Medical School Tool and Deadlines

Pay close attention to every message sent from us and the AAMC about the "AMCAS Choose Your Medical School" tool which will be activated soon. Every student, even Early Decision students, must use the tool to indicate where they will matriculate.

- The "Plan to Enroll" option becomes available on Feb 19, 2025, and everyone is encouraged to follow the AMCAS instructions about how to "Plan to Enroll" to WVU SoM.
- The "Commit to Enroll" option becomes available on April 30, 2025. We have strict deadlines for all students to "Commit to Enroll" to WVU SoM as follows:
 - The Commit to Enroll deadline for MD students is May 31, 2025.
 - The Commit to Enroll deadline for MD/PhD students is May 1, 2025.

Our Class must be finalized by May 31, 2025, as our first graded assignment is released to the Class on June 1, 2025.
