Here are my most important notes at the end of this admissions cycle:

1. Your first medical school assignment in SOLE is now accessible to all students who have SOLE access. **The deadline to complete this assignment is July 22, 2025, at 4:00 pm ET.**
2. All pre-matriculation tasks listed in The Doctor Is In must be completed by the stated deadlines. For the safety of you and your patients, participation in graded clinical experiences **will be suspended** until your health information forms are complete. Do not be late in completing this important task!
3. The **last webinar for your Class is on Wednesday, June 25, 2025, from 3:30 - 4:30 pm ET.** We will discuss professional development week and any pertinent pre-matriculation information. Zoom Room:

5. You should now get in the habit of **checking your mix.wvu.edu email address daily.** Be on the lookout for the weekly distributed "**Message of the Week**" and other correspondence from the Office of Student Services and our Director of Medical Education, Amy Drvar.
6. Be prompt for your first day of school. **Arrive no later than 8:00 a.m. EST on July 23, 2025,** at the Health Sciences Center. Dress professionally because headshots will be obtained for your class roster.
7. In AMCAS, the Choose Your Medical School Tool report indicates that 10 members of the class are still on one or more waitlists at other schools. According to AMCAS, selecting "Commit to Enroll" indicates that the applicant has made a final selection and withdrawn all other applications. Please be sure that you have notified all other schools that you have committed to enroll elsewhere and must be removed from their waitlists.
